Report on Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra

Thiruvannamalai District Krishi Vigyan Kendra has successfully conducted the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra in Tiruvannamalai District from 15th November 2023 to 21st January 2024 covering 860 Grama panchayats with the cooperation of his Excellency Shri. K. Muruges, District Collector, Tiruvannamalai District.

The main objective of the event is to raise awareness and facilitate the delivery of various centrally sponsored welfare schemes benefits. As part of Hamara Sankalp Viksit campaign, it is focusing on reaching the vulnerable population, disseminating information, learning from citizens and enrolling potential beneficiaries under various centrally sponsored schemes.

The Programme was inaugurated by the Honourable Prime Minister of India in three tribal districts viz., Thiruvannamalai, Salem and The Nilgiris 15.11.2023. In Thiruvannamalai district the inaugural event was held in Thenmalai Athipattu and Kallathur villages in Jawadhu Hills.

Honourable Governor of Tamil Nadu Shri. R.N. Ravi on Thursday 16.11.2023 flagged off the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra van at the Forestry Higher Secondary School in Kovilur village near Jamunamarathur, Jawadhu Hills, Tiruvannamalai. He shared his ideas on tribal area development, and interacted with tribal farmers. He also distributed vegetable seed kits and soil health cards to 100 farmers sponsored by ICAR KVK and IIHR, Bengaluru, new gas connections to tribal families, kisan credit cards and NRLM loan to self help groups as part of the initiative.

On the occasion, Shri B. Muruges, District Collector, Thiruvannamalai District, Dr.Shaik.N.Meera, Director, ATARI, ICAR, Hyderabad, Shri. R.Shankar Narayanan, Chief General Manager, NABARD, Tamil Nadu, Shri. S. Ramesh,

President, ICAR Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Mr. Annadurai, DIG, PIB, Chennai and Mr. V. Suresh, Senior Scientist and Head, ICAR KVK, Kilnelli were present. A total of 684 tribal farmers participated in the event.

Union Minister of State for Chemicals and Fertilizers Mr. Bhagwant Khuba participated in Vikshit Bharat Sankalp Yatra at Thandampattu and Melamanjanur villages in Thandampattu block on 21st and 22nd November 2023. He reviewed the progress of VBSY with line departmental officials.

Shri Brij Lal, Chairman of Parliamentary Committee on Home Affairs, New Delhi participated in the VBSY yatra in Thiruvannamalai district from 02.01.2024 to 04.01.2024 and distributed various welfare schemes to the public.

To achieve 100% target in Thiruvannamalai district, Shri. D. Senthil Pandian, IAS, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Earth Sciences, Govt. of India, New Delhi participated and reviewed the VBSY activities in Thiruvannamalai on 09.01.2024. He had participated in the VBSY event held at Mampattu village in Vandavasi block of Thiruvannamalai district and explained the importance of the event for the benefit of the farmers and general public. He also distributed free gas cylinders under Ujwala Scheme, Kisan Credit card to, Soil health cards, loans to 5 SHGs for the entrepreneurial activities and Ayushman Bharat cards.

The main attraction of the Vikshit Bharat Sankalp Yatra was the demonstration of Agridrones by Madras Fertilizers Limited. Drone demonstrations were conducted on all 860 GPs.

With the support of Indian Council of Agricultural Research, New Delhi, ATARI, ICAR, Zone X, Hyderabad, Director of Extension Education, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore, Lead Bank, NABARD, Indian Oil Corporation, Department of Posts, Joint Director of Agriculture/Project Director ATMA, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting and local panchayat leaders, the ICAR Krishi Vigyan Kendra has successfully completed Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra in all 860 GPs on 21.01.2024.
